REQUIREMENTS

Our school is mixed, day and boarding, with “O” and “A” levels offering both Arts and Sciences.

Security: The school is enclosed in a gate, so learners are expected to report at 6:50 am and leave at 5:00pm from Monday to Saturday.

Uniform: The uniform will be provided at school;

Scholastic materials:

Every learner should come with enough exercise books, a mathematical set, calculator, dictionary, bible/Koran.

Requirements for boarders.

Mattress, bed sheets, towel, mosquito net, basin/bucket, plate, cup, fork, black covered shoes, two pairs of black trousers, two black skirts, enough pocket money, underwear. Knickers, pads (for girl children).

Other requirements:

- (i) One ream of paper (Printing papers for S.1, S.2, and S.4, Ruled for S.3, S.5 and S.6)
- (ii) 6 rolls of Toilet papers (for all students)
- (iii) Three packets of sanitary towels for girls (Always).

- (iv) Two black skirts for girls and two pairs of black trousers for boys. (**NOTE:** all other clothes must be left home for boarders).
- (v) One bucket and one jerrycan for every student (boarders).
- (vi) Hand sanitizer for every student.
- (vii) Enough books, calculator and other scholastic materials.
- (viii) One squeezer for every student. (For those who never brought).
- (ix) One broom.
- (x) Two plastic folder files.
- (xi) School identity card (5000/=) found at school.
- (xii) Plate, cup and fork (10,000/=) found at school.

NOTE: Admission fees is 10,000=

School fees:

All learners must pay 100% of the school fees on reporting day.

RULES/GUIDELINES FOR CONSTRUCTIVE BEHAVIOUR AT STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL – NYAMWAMBA.

PLEASE NOTE: Standard high school – Nyamwamba should accept admission in the school after a decision to abide by the following rules and regulations.

1. All students will be required to abide by the daily school routine or else will be advised to go back home.
2. Students shall be punctual for beginning of term, lessons, assembly, games, morning and evening preps. A suitable punishment shall be given to offenders.
3. Students shall not miss lessons, tests and examinations of any kind. Offenders will be suspended for one week and report back with a parent.
4. No special meal shall be given to an individual student.
5. All kinds of cooking are not allowed in the school. Offenders will be asked to leave the school immediately.
6. Students shall be expected to obey and respect teachers, student leaders and all employees of the school. Offenders shall be indefinitely suspended.
7. Students shall remain within bounds of the school at all times. Leaving school without permission is self-expulsion.
8. Teasing and bullying is taken as a serious offense and any student caught in the act will be asked to leave the school with immediate effect.
9. All forms of immorality will not be allowed in the school and any offender will be immediately sent out of school.
10. All students shall make every effort to protect a good image of the school by avoiding action that can embarrass members of the public.
11. Unauthorized visitors are not allowed in the school. Boarders shall receive visitors only on visiting days. Whoever attends a visitor without authority from office will be in for suspension of one week.
12. Staff quarters are out of bounds to all students at all times. Culprits shall be suspended for one week.
13. All students are responsible for keeping their classrooms, dormitories, and the surrounding environment clean and tidy all the time.
14. The school uniform must be worn at all the class hours except during weekends. On special occasions and outings, students will also put on uniform or else will be in for suspension.
15. **Radios and Mobile Phones** are strictly forbidden in school. Whoever shall be found in possession of any, will be expelled.
16. Sick students shall be treated at school and cases beyond the school nurse will be referred to a higher medical facility at a parent's cost.
